

Environmental Responsibility Statement

Galeria SENDA is a contemporary art gallery based in Barcelona providing an online, buy-now marketplace with emerging and established international artists. SENDA is committed to reducing carbon emissions and adopting sustainable practices throughout the gallery's value chain.

At SENDA, we are deeply committed to environmental responsibility and sustainability. As a member of the [Gallery Climate Coalition \(GCC\)](#) and a founding constituent of the GCC Spain branch, we embrace our role in promoting positive change within the contemporary art community. For over a decade, we have been dedicated to adopting green practices and reducing our environmental footprint in various operations pertaining both to the gallery itself and our involvement with international art fairs.

Through continuous efforts, we have made significant strides in reducing emissions across our gallery. Our focus areas include energy conservation, sustainable packaging, and responsible travel. In collaboration with artists and all stakeholders in the value chain, we actively encourage the adoption of sustainable practices throughout the art industry, however small.

As part of our commitment to a greener future, we have appointed a dedicated Sustainability Ambassador, and our entire team is driven by a collective passion for reducing emissions. Looking ahead, we have set ambitious goals for the coming years, and are actively working to establish an internal framework to meet our commitments.

- By 2030, we aim to eliminate plastic packaging entirely from our operations, while partnering with local textile manufacturers to create reusable covers for the delivery and storage of artworks.
- We seek to achieve a 50% reduction in carbon emissions from our 2023 baseline, by 2033.
- Partner with shipping companies that are also committed to functioning as net-zero as possible, with priority to electric vehicles.
- Establishing the gallery as a space for dialogue and promotion of sustainable practices to audiences, artists, and other industry collaborators.
- Continue carrying out pro-bono work as founding members of the Gallery Climate Coalition Spain, and publishing the 2023 footprint results in mid-2024.

At Galeria SENDA, we firmly believe that every small step towards sustainability contributes to a more significant positive impact on our planet. As we move forward, we will continue to innovate, collaborate, and advocate for a more sustainable art industry and a healthier environment for generations to come.
